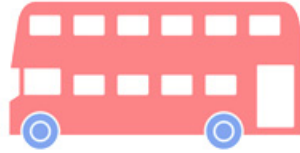

Newspaper Review

Task description: find a recent political news story that you find interesting. Describe (with precise detail) the news story and explain why you have found that story interesting.

How to get the grade that you want:

Level	Mark scheme	Marks awarded
1	<p><i>Simple description based on old political news story. No analysis or evaluation.</i></p> <p>*Implicitly relevant news story found(which select from or paraphrase / copied from the source). Grade: 1-2</p> <p>*Answers which attempt to describe a story (no explanation). Grade: 3</p>	
2	<p><i>Supported evaluation of the news story.</i></p> <p>*Answers which describe a recent news story and simple explanation given for why the story was interesting (Grade: 4)</p> <p>*Answers which describe a recent news story and one developed explanation given for why the story was interesting (little depth of evaluation). (Grade: 5)</p>	
3	<p><i>Developed evaluation of the news story.</i></p> <p>*A good description of a news story (political details are present) and one developed explanation given for why the story was interesting (good depth of evaluation). (Grade: 6)</p> <p>*An excellent description of a news story (many precise political details are present) and two developed explanations given for why the story was interesting (good depth of evaluation). (Grade: 7)</p>	
4	<p><i>Sustained evaluation, explicitly focused on the new story, reviewing alternative views before giving a balanced judgement.</i></p> <p>An excellent description of the news story. The story is fully described with full, precise political details. An excellent analysis is present throughout the story.</p> <p>*Explicit explanation and analysis present. Grade 8</p> <p>*Explicit judgement comparing the relative importance of two or more other news stories. Grade 9.</p>

4/5 = only uses facts from the House of Commons documentary

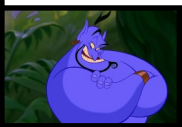
6= Above, plus uses facts from the workbook.
